Judges: **Mark Taylor and Michelle Ansell** Confined to dogs of a breed which Hunt, Point and Retrieve which have not gained an award or COM at a field trial, been placed first, second or third in an open GWT or first in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations.
